# 2026-03 London meeting information

The spring 2026 meeting of WG 21 is being hosted by Shaved Yaks Ltd, with support from Citadel Securities and the Standard C++ Foundation. The meeting will run, online and on-site, from **March 23-28, 2026**, with an on-site orientation session for first-time attendees on **March 22nd**.

The hotel is both the in-person meeting location and the recommended lodging. Internet access is included in your hotel room rate and provided in meeting spaces.

## Remote participation

The committee continues to provide as close to a first-class experience for remote participants as possible. Zoom connection details will be provided closer to the time via the meeting email list and on the London 2026 meeting wiki.

## The venue

The Hilton London Croydon is a nice, modern, hotel, just outside the centre of London. All meeting rooms are on-site and we have a reserved block of rooms that you should use if you will be staying in the venue hotel, itself. There are other hotels and accommodation options around, but the Hilton is reasonably priced with decent quality rooms, so makes a good default option for most participants.

Our block room rate is:

£149 GBP per night for single occupancy (double occupancy will be a little extra)


## Meals and refreshments

Tea and coffee, along with fruit and pastries, will be provided during three breaks. Attendees are responsible for their own meals.

## Getting there

The Hilton London Croydon hotel is about 17 minutes walk, or 4 minutes by taxi, from Waddon Station, just outside Croydon in South London. There is also a regular bus service from Waddon.

It is also 28 minutes walk, 6 minutes by taxi, or also accessible by bus, from South Croydon. South Croydon may be preferred if coming from Gatwick Airport as it is on the same train line.



## By air

If it's an option for you then Gatwick (LGW) is the best positioned for access to the venue, with regular trains running straight from the airport to South Croydon (see above) taking about 20-25 minutes.

## By car

If you are driving in, then parking is available onsite, at a cost of £17/ day. Please also be aware that Croydon falls with London's Low Emissions Zone (LEZ), so you may be subject to charges under that scheme (see: <https://tfl.gov.uk/modes/driving/low-emission-zone/about-the-lez>).

## Visas

It is up to you to determine if you require a visa to visit the UK. However, as a result of a recent change, **most visitors now require either a visa or an ETA**. Please see: <https://www.gov.uk/eta> for more information.

## Restaurants

There is a restaurant onsite at the hotel, and a few fast-food restaurants (Pizza Hut, KFC, McDonalds) in the adjoining commercial park. Additional restaurants are a little further. Most recommended restaurants are about a 30 minute walk or 10 minute drive or Uber - so organising small groups is advised.
